



Product management resides solely in the problem space.







Agile Development

Definition of Agile

Agile is a collective term for a group of product development methods, such as SCRUM, DSDM, Crystal, FDD, and XP, which all reside in the solution space (designing and building a product).



Agile and Product Management

Agile and Solution Space

Agile development methods are not product management methodologies since the product management domain resides in the problem space (identifying and articulating market problems, from a product planning perspective).

The Lead Developer always manages the development team and creates any required technical documents and specifications.



Problem Space	Solution Space	
Product Planner	Product Architect	Product Owner
Identify and articulate market requirements	Devise functional solution	Scope for Sprint, Manage a release
MRD	Product Backlog, User Stories	Release

Product Architect now writes the product backlog and user stories (instead of PRD and use cases), with a Product Owner role inserted between the Product Architect and the Lead Developer.

Agile Product Owner

The product owner is responsible for the success of the product.



Constraints: One (overall) product owner per product; must be respected.

Agile Development

Successful Agile Implementation Rules

- 1. Product Owner resides in the solution space.
- 2. Product Owner only manages scope and sprint.
- 3. Product Architect builds and maintains backlog.




Definition of User Experience

User Experience (UX) is an occupational domain that is broadly responsible to shape the sensory, behavioral and emotional aspects of a user's interaction with the product.




User **Experience**



User Experience Placement

- UX resides in the solution space.
- UX is integrated into product development.
- UX is organizationally located under the Engineering unit, with Development and Quality Assurance.

Blackblot Corporate Organizational Structure



Successful UX Integration Rules

- 1. User Experience is in the solution space and comprised of sensory design & interaction design.
- 2. The UX Expert is responsible for the product's Externals ("Dashboard" sensory and interaction).
- 3. The Lead Developer is responsible for the product's Internals ("Engine" technology).

The product's Externals and Internals are joined to create a functional, usable and esthetic product.

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


